Internet Safety

With technology playing such a significant role in society today, we take internet safety extremely seriously. We have an Online Safety Policy that provides guidance for teachers and children about how to use the internet safely. Every year group participates in lessons on Online Safety and children understand how to stay safe when using technology

Children are given regular guidance about how to stay safe online as part of each unit in our curriculum. The online safety lessons taught each half term enable children to:

- Gain a vast understanding of e-safety across a range of devices, networks and social media platforms (which is progressive and age appropriate).
- Be exposed to a range of presentation methods, which are used as vehicles within topics to create stop motion animation
- Share information through PowerPoints, word documents and express views via Google Classroom.

Children have the opportunity to use websites and platforms as pathways to research given topics, where they will have the skills to identify whether a source is reliable (whether it is based on correct information).

Furthermore, during PSHE sessions and assemblies – led by digital safety specialists and staff members, all of our children are taught how to keep their information safe and use technology safely and responsibly.

It is crucial that Rokesly Junior School's children leave us, being able to confidently use technology and safely communicate online, ensuring that they are well-equipped for the next stage in their education and beyond.

We endeavour to support parents through workshops and regular communication via the school website where they can find help as well as links to information and websites.
