Dear Parents/Carers,

The online face to face teaching of small groups is due to start this week. It will be a good opportunity for class teachers to support children with their learning through tailored tutor groups.

As of next week the teachers will be teaching one weekly English session per group in the mornings and one weekly maths session per group in the afternoons. Details of the afternoon sessions to follow. Please ensure when joining that your child uses a name that we are able to recognise.

As you may know, as a school we work closely with the other schools local to us as part of a network learning community (NLC). I meet with the head teachers of the schools on a weekly basis and we regularly discuss the provision in each of our schools. These discussions help us to reflect on the provision at our individual schools. The other schools in our network start the day with an informal morning registration (not teaching) live meeting for the whole class. We feel that this a good way to start the day so both Rokesly Infants and Rokesly Junior School will be starting to do this too. The Infants school are starting later on this week and the Junior school are starting next week. We know from parental feedback that not all children will be able to attend the registration that will be taking place at 8.45am every morning so we shall continue to upload the daily videos from the teachers too.

Next week we will be introducing daily Zoom drop in sessions with the class teacher between 3.00pm and 3.15pm. The sessions (which are non-compulsory), will be a chance for you or your child to have a brief informal chat with the teacher. More details to follow.

If support is needed for a particular aspect of work please email your child's class teacher with information about the issue so that it can be addressed during the tutor group time or in the work set for the next day.
